OXFORD UNITED FOOTBALL CLUB DREAMING SPIRES TERMS & CONDITIONS



These terms and conditions apply to The Oxford United Football Club Dreaming Spires community giving back competition 2024.

- 1. By entering this competition, the entrant will be deemed to have read and understood these terms and conditions and agreed to be bound by them.
- 2. This competition is organised by Oxford United Football Club Limited ("OUFC").
- 3. There will be ten (10) winners who will each receive a £1,000 grant. Organisations will be required to evidence the costs being incurred prior to a grant being distributed. Such evidence of the expenditure being incurred will include, for example, invoices, proof of payments, proposals and quotes. Once supporting documentation has been received, we aim to make the payment within four weeks. This is only possible if the information is supplied to us by the stated deadline. If the information is supplied late, this will delay your payment. If funds are found not to have been utilised for their intended purpose, OUFC reserves its rights to claw back the grant and issue legal proceedings where necessary to recover the grant.

 - b. Your organisation.
 - c. Tell us about the organisation in no more than 150 words.
 - d. Tell us in no more than 150 words what you would you spend the £1,000 on (for example: to support kit and equipment purchases, facility improvements, volunteer training and coaching requirements).
 - e. What would winning the competition mean to your organisation? (250 words max).
- 5. All entries must be received by OUFC by 23.59 on 12th April 2024. Entries received after this closing date and time will not be valid.
- 6. Any entry which is incomplete, illegible, incorrectly submitted or otherwise does not comply with the terms and conditions may be deemed invalid.
- 7. By submitting your entry, you are agreeing to these terms and conditions. You accept that:
 - a. OUFC will use your details to administer your prize if you win.

- b. As a competition entrant, OUFC may publish your organisation's name.

- 11. The winners will be notified at the earliest opportunity. Each winner will have 14 working days to accept the offered prize. If they do not respond OUFC reserves the right to select a different organisation from the entries and the previous winner would no longer be entitled to the prize.
- 12. The winners will be announced on OUFC digital platforms and via a press release.
 Winners will be expected to collaborate with OUFC on joint communications and PR activity.
- 13. OUFC retains copyright of each entry.
- 14. In the event of any dispute regarding the competition, OUFC's decision shall be binding and final.

You can't submit an application if: You don't live in the UK; If your organisation isn't registered, based and delivering in Oxfordshire; you're under 18 years old; you're an employee or associate of OUFC or the OUFC Stadium Project team.
